Lower Smite Farm visit – Thursday 11th July

On Thursday 11th July classes Kestrels and Owls will be visiting Lower Smite Farm to study plants and animals in the environment, which supports our science and geography curriculum. Due to the outdoor nature of this trip, the children will need to wear outdoor clothing (including a light-weight waterproof jacket) and sensible footwear (trainers or wellies depending on the weather). If the weather is sunny, it may also be advisable to send a sun hat in to school and apply long lasting sun cream before the children leave home.

A packed lunch will be provided by Class Catering or, if preferred, can be brought from home. Please indicate on the slip below whether your child would prefer ham or cheese sandwiches or if you would prefer to supply your own packed lunch. They will also require a drink (not fizzy) and a snack, which they should carry with their lunch, in a back-pack.
